

Re: Randall County Court at Law No. 2

PERTAINING TO DEFAULT MATTERS

1. Service must be proper and in strict accordance or compliance with the T.R.C.P.; and statutory and case law as applicable.
2. As previously stated, if **child support** is requested, there must be documentary or reliable evidence such as income tax returns, check stubs, or other such evidence to support a child support request; unless minimum wage child support is requested. If such evidence is not available, there must be testimony substantiating reasonable efforts to obtain same.
3. Also, if **property issues** are involved, necessary and sufficient documentary or other reliable evidence must be introduced or presented in connection with the relief requested.
4. Also, in general sufficient and reliable evidence must be presented or introduced to support any relief requested.
