

Maintenance Technician I

Applications are now being accepted for a Maintenance Technician I with Randall County Juvenile Services/Youth Center of the High Plains. This position may require some nights, weekends and holidays. Submission to a drug test and background check is required. Randall County is an E.O.E.

DEFINITION

This position involves the general maintenance, cleanliness, and appearance of the buildings and grounds of the Youth Center of the High Plains. May involve supervision of juvenile trustees in various community service work assignments. Technician I's may be required to be on call and available after hours and on weekends.

Education:

- At least 21 years of age
- High school or GED required

Experience:

- One year experience in maintenance field

Licenses or Certificates:

Pre-Hire:

- Current Texas driver's license (and insurable)

After Hire:

- Non-commercial pesticide applicator license

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge of:

- Excellent knowledge of mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and carpentry equipment and tools, and grounds maintenance.
- Knowledge of safety practices

Ability to:

- Consistently model appropriate behaviors of maturity, character, judgment, anger management, and self-control
- Monitor and supervise juveniles working community service assignments
- Perform work in areas of mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and carpentry
- Operate and maintain equipment necessary to perform assigned tasks
- Prioritize pending repairs and tasks in order of importance

WORKING CONDITIONS

Environmental Conditions:

Work is done both indoors and outdoors, depending upon assignment and need, including periods of inclement weather. The indoor setting is designated as tobacco free. Requires work with juvenile offenders in and around a secure juvenile detention facility. This position involves daily contact with juvenile offenders in detention and/or on probation. Involves significant contact with other professionals within the Youth Center and the Juvenile Probation Department.

Physical Conditions:

This position involves long periods of walking and standing, the use of ladders, scaffolding, power tools and other equipment, and the occasional lifting of heavy objects and equipment.

Salary:

Salary range is \$45,726.33 depending upon qualifications and experience, plus full county benefits which include health plan, dental, vision, bereavement leave, longevity pay, holiday, vacation, and sick leave, etc.
