

Facility Custodian – Part Time

DEFINITION

It is the responsibility of the Facility Custodian to ensure the cleanliness and appearance of buildings and grounds of the Youth Center of the High Plains.

Required:

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Have a high school education or GED

Essential duties and responsibilities:

- Perform scheduled cleaning of all buildings and grounds.
- Inspect all buildings and grounds for any safety or security problems.
- Maintain all cleaning equipment and ensure proper inventory of janitorial supplies and cleaning equipment for the facility.
- Removing snow and applying ice melt to walkways, parking lots, and driveways.

Knowledge of:

- Proper cleaning practices.
- Proper use of cleaning chemicals.
- Safety practices using various equipment and chemicals.

Experience:

One year's experience in janitorial field.

Salary: Part Time – Starting pay is \$10.00 an hour with a total of 10 hours per week.
