UTILITY JOINT USE AGREEMENT**

The Randall County Commissioners will allow the location on the right -of -way of your proposed \_\_\_\_\_ line as shown by accompanying drawings and notice dated \_\_\_\_\_ except as noted below.

It is expressly understood that Randall County does not purport, hereby, to grant any right, claim, title or easement in or upon this highway, and it is further understood that Randall County may require the Owner to relocate this line, subject to provisions of governing laws, by giving ninety (90) days written notice.

\_\_\_\_\_ shall hold harmless and indemnify the Commissioners Court of Randall County Texas against any and all damages to property or injuries to persons caused by the proposed construction, and by acceptance of this approval agrees to make all changes and alterations to said pipeline as may be required in connection with alteration, paving or relocation of any public road, without cost to Randall County.

All work on the highway right -of -way shall be performed in accordance with Randall County Road Superintendent's instructions. The installation shall not damage any part of the highway and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent property owners. Special specifications for placing this pipeline are as follows:

1. If the road is crossed, the line shall be placed in a casing that has been placed through a hole bored beneath the road.
2. The line shall be encased from right -of -way line to right -of -way line unless otherwise approved.
3. All borings of paved highways shall extend for the full width of the paving and a minimum of ten (10) feet on each side thereof. For gravel or earthen roads the bore shall be for the full width of the road bed plus a minimum of ten (10) feet on each side.
4. The casings shall be approximately the same diameter as the bore hole.
5. All pipe shall be well covered beneath grade line in ditches in order not to interfere with the maintenance of the ditches. Provide a minimum of forty-two (42) inches of cover at lowest point.
6. The Road Superintendent shall be given at least five days' notice of the actual starting of the work.
7. A copy of the Joint Use Agreement shall be on the site during the construction.
