1. **REVIEW OF MINUTES:** Motion to approve the minutes as presented for the meeting held on February 26th, 2021 was made by Nina Parvin and 2nd by Mark Benton. Carried 10/0.
2. **CORRESPONDENCE:** To receive, review and discuss correspondence to the Randall County Bail Bond Board.
 - A. Received \$1,877.50 additional collateral from Bail Bonds by Judy on 3/15/21. Their limit has been increased accordingly by the SO.
3. **REPORTS ON BONDING COMPANIES:** To receive monthly report on bonding companies operating in Randall County. This includes discussion and any necessary action.
 - A. The board decided to distribute the company reports to the bonding companies via email instead of printing hard copies. We will try this for a couple of months and re-evaluate then.

 - D. Remove Tamikka Williams from Savior Bail Bonds – badge was lost so nothing to return.

 - A. Approved new application for Allstate Bail Bonds; License #01-129, Agent Joshua Nelson. License will become effective when collateral is received. Motion was made by Angie Parker and 2nd by Susan Allen. Carried 10/0.

 - C. Received new application for Freedom Bail Bonds II, Agent Christopher Konnecke. Motion made by Nina Parvin and 2nd by Susan Allen. Carried 10/0.
